

The Faison School Clinic is open on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday each month from 9:00 am and 1:00 pm.

What the Clinic offers:

- The Clinic will provide assessment and training services including educational assessments, behavioral assessments, parent education, ABA training, and program evaluations.

Example of clinical services might include:

- ABLLS/VB-Mapp
- Brigance Diagnostic Inventory of Basic Skills
- Pre-Vocational/Vocational
- Person Centered Planning
- Functional Behavior Assessment and/or Analysis
- Preference Assessment

If you are interested in seeking clinical services, please contact the Clinic for information as to whether or not an administration of a specific assessment or training falls under the expertise of the clinic staff. If the assessment or training falls outside the Faison School expertise, we will not be able to provide the service.

The services will be available to interested family members or to providers working with individuals with disabilities in the community. Clinical services are available to individuals not currently enrolled at the School.

How does it work?

- The Director of Clinical Services or another qualified professional participating in delivering the services will prepare a Service Plan detailing the goals of the service and steps to achieve the goals. The Service Plan will be agreed upon and signed by the family and/or the provider seeking the services, the Faison Clinical Director, and any other individual involved in delivery of the service. The consent to implement the Service Plan must be obtained from the parent or guardian before services begin.
- The Faison School does not provide transportation. The family or provider will need to transport the child to all clinic appointments.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for appointments not cancelled 24 hours in advance.
