The Faison Center for Applied Behavior Analysis is committed to serving children and adults in a variety of capacities to meet the wide array of needs for Virginians with developmental disabilities. The Center is located on the campus of The Faison School for Autism and provides a variety of services between 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, which include:

Service	Service Overview	Hourly Rate
Aftercare Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Adaptive behavior services from 2:15-6pm, Monday through Thursday; in a 1:1 instructional framework</li> <li>▪ Two (either M/W or T/R) or four-day options are available</li> <li>▪ Individualized programming, with data collection and analysis (on targeted behaviors)</li> <li>▪ Formal, quarterly progress updates; containing information about areas of progress, difficulty, etc..</li> <li>▪ Behavior Intervention planning – individualized by student</li> <li>▪ Medication administration, assistance with snack/dinner, and/or activities of daily living</li> </ul>	\$50
Adaptive Behavior Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Adaptive assessments administered include but are not limited to the VB-MAPP, ABLLS-R, Brigance assessments (e.g., CIBS and TSI), and C-PIRK.</li> <li>▪ Assessments are typically conducted at the Faison Center for ABA and range in length from 3-10 hours.</li> </ul>	\$50-110
Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ FBAs require direct observation of target behavior, data collection, and interviews with primary caregivers and service providers.</li> <li>▪ Assessments are typically conducted in the client’s natural setting and range in length from 5-8 hours.</li> </ul>	\$110
Preference Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Conducted to identify preferences, motivators, etc. Often done in combination with FBA in preparation for developing a behavior plan.</li> <li>▪ Assessments are typically conducted at the Faison Center for ABA and range in length from 2-3 hours.</li> </ul>	\$50
Functional Analysis (FA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Functional Analyses are typically conducted to identify a function (cause) of mild to severe problem behavior using systematic and controlled experimental procedures.</li> <li>▪ Assessments are typically conducted at the Faison Center for ABA and range in length from 5-15 hours.</li> </ul>	\$250
Transition Assessment & Planning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Informal and formal transition assessments and Person-Centered Planning meetings can all be conducted at the Faison Center resulting in direct training, recommendations, and consultative services.</li> <li>▪ Assessments are typically conducted at the Faison Center for ABA and range in length from 4-6 hours.</li> </ul>	\$50-\$110
Assistive Technology Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ An assistive technology team assesses and guides the referral process through formal, data-guided means, to determine the potential utility of certain assistive technologies.</li> <li>▪ Assessments are typically conducted at the Faison Center for ABA and range in length from 3-10 hours.</li> </ul>	\$50-110
In-Home Consultative Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ In-home services may include but are not limited to consulting on behavior problems, toilet training, adaptive behavior curriculum development, social skills training, and parent/caregiver training.</li> <li>▪ Services take place in the client’s home or other locations outside of the Faison Center for ABA.</li> </ul>	\$50-110

Parent Training and Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Parents may participate in workshops or direct training to address the behavioral and adaptive needs of their child.</li> <li>▪ Services may occur at the Faison Center for ABA or an affiliated program.</li> </ul>	\$50-110
Social Skills Training & Curriculum Planning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Direct training and consultation with caregivers may be used to improve social skills.</li> <li>▪ The creation of individualized, social skills curriculum may be developed for the individual for his/her own use or conducted at the Faison Center for ABA.</li> </ul>	\$50-110
Speech/Language Therapy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Direct, 1:1 services and/or consultation provided by a licensed Speech/Language Pathologist.</li> <li>▪ All services provided at the Faison Center for ABA.</li> </ul>	\$120
BCBA and BCaBA Supervision	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The Faison Center and Faison School certified behavior analysts are available to provide professional supervision hours for those individuals working towards obtaining a behavior analyst certification.</li> </ul>	\$50-110

*Admissions*

The admissions process consists of a parent or caregiver interview and a client observation at the Faison Center for ABA. Information obtained from the interview and observation allows us to determine what level of services will be most appropriate to meet the needs of the client. Learning and behavioral challenges, such as toileting difficulties and problem behaviors that interfere with learning and daily functioning, are some examples of behaviors that can be targeted for intervention at the Center. Center staff reserve the right to decline provision of services to individuals if it is determined that the Faison Center for ABA is not the most appropriate provider of recommended services and/or do not have the available resources at the time of referral.
